QUAPAW TRIBAL RESOLUTION #11279B

- WHEREAS, the Quapaw Tribe of Oklahoma is a federally recognized Indian Tribe, and
- WHEREAS, the Quapaw Tribe is currently eligible for a grant through/and from the Department of Health, Education, and Welfare, through the Indian Health Service via the Indian Self-Determination Grants Program, as provided under Public Law 93-638, and
- WHEREAS, under the governing document of the Quapaw Tribe of Oklahoma, and by resolution passed July 16, 1978, Quapaw Tribe's General Council, the Business Committee was given the authority to ask for and submit proposals for federal programs provided by the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Indian Health Service, and other federal agencies, and
- WHEREAS, the Quapaw Tribal Business Committee does support the letter of intent to contract programs from the Indian Health Service, which includes, "Development of a Tribal Health Management Structure," Training and Technical Assistance, and Matching Fund, for the Quapaw Tribe.
