

TRIBAL RESOLUTION

We, the Quapaw Tribe of Oklahoma request the Bureau of Indian Affairs to enter into three contracts, with the Inter-Tribal Council. They are the Arts and Crafts, the Tribal Operations, and the Adult Education:

WHEREAS, the Arts and Crafts will enhance upon the Indian population to further develop and financially supplement the Indian community, and,

WHEREAS, the Tribal Operations position will serve to be a liaison between our Tribe and the Bureau of Indian Affairs, and,

WHEREAS, the Adult Education will continue to upgrade the general educational level of the Indian community, and,

WHEREAS, this resolution represents the full authorization for the Inter-Tribal Council (carte blanche) to apply for, negotiate, and contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs, and,

WHEREAS, the President and Executive Director offices of the Inter-Tribal Council shall be the designed officials for all correspondence, and,

WHEREAS, this request should commence on October 1, 1976, and should be valid for the duration of fiscal year 1977, and any transitional period that may be addendum, and,

WHEREAS, this resolution was voted on by the governing board of the Quapaw Tribe this 20th day of June, 1976, with a voting record reflective of 0 yeas and 6 neas.
