The Quapaw Nation Environmental Office will conduct a public meeting to present and discuss the proposed remedial activities at the Chat Base 199 and Marketable Chat Piles properties.

This will be an “open house” meeting with no formal presentations. The public is invited to visit anytime during the scheduled hours to view exhibits, ask questions, and offer comments.

Chat Base 199 (CB199) is located east of N 560 County Road and just west of N 565 County Road west of Cardin, OK within Operable Unit 4. More specifically, CB199 is located within Section 31, Township 29 North, and Range 23 East.

Remedial action activities at CP021, CP073 and CB076 will include the hauling of marketable chat to a processor. This will allow marketable chat to be taken to processors when they are able to accept it (during the construction season).
