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Quapaw Nation Higher Education Concurrent Classes/Dual Credit Assistance Program

Tuition & Fees: Pays \$100.00 per credit hour (maximum 9 credit hours per semester), regardless of what student pays or does not pay.

Eligibility Criteria/Requirements:

- +Enrolled Member of the Quapaw Nation, *eligible for services at time application is submitted.*
- +Most current official high school transcript.
- +Letter of Approval from *high school counselor.*
- +Letter of Approval from *parent/guardian.*
- +Semester class schedule from high school.
- +Completed application.
- +Semester class schedule from college with itemized billing statement (must show cost of tuition and fees).
- + Students must maintain a “C” or 2.0 GPA or better in their funded classes.

SUSPENSION of ASSISTANCE DUE TO GPA/GRADES

- If a student does not earn a grade letter of “C” or above, or a GPA of 2.0 or above, in his or her concurrent/dual credit class(es) funded by Quapaw Nation Higher Education (QNHE), that student will be given one (1) semester to raise his or her grade(s).
- If, at the end of the second semester, the student is still below a “C” or 2.0 in the QNHE funded concurrent/dual credit class(es), he or she will be suspended from the QNHE Concurrent/Dual Credit Funding Assistance until the student’s grade(s) or GPA in concurrent/dual credit class(es) is at a “C” or above, or 2.0 or above.
- At that time, the student can apply for funding and QNHE will consider his or her application on a case-by-case basis.

Quapaw Nation Higher Education Advanced Placement (AP) Classes Assistance Program

Pays for the AP exam fees for AP classes*, maximum 3 classes per year.

Pays toward fees required by the individual AP class or classes, up to \$50.00 per year, per class.

Current AP exam fees: Regular--\$94; Seminar/Research--\$142

***Students must provide the information showing whether or not they qualify for an Exam Fee Reduction. If a student qualifies for an Exam Fee Reduction, that is the amount that will be paid.**

Eligibility Criteria/Requirements:

- +Enrolled Member of the Quapaw Nation, *eligible for services at time application is submitted.*
- +Most current official high school transcript.
- +Letter of Approval from *high school counselor.*
- +Letter of Approval from *parent/guardian.*
- +Semester class schedule from high school.
- +Completed application.
- +Proof of registration for exam OR receipt of payment for exam.
- +Receipt for individual class fees (if fees are required).
- +Students must maintain a “C” or 2.0 GPA or better in their funded classes.

What are Advanced Placement Classes?

AP classes are another form of college credit available to high school students. AP classes are rigorous by design just like dual credit and concurrent classes. Here are the differences:

- >**AP** classes do not require students to pay tuition. Instead, students **must pay to take the AP exam after the school year ends**. If a student’s exam score is high enough, then s/he earns college credits for that course.
- >**AP** classes sometimes have **fees** due before taking the class. This varies from school district to school district. Students may be required to complete reading or other assignments ahead of the semester.
- >**AP** classes are usually taken by high school juniors and seniors; occasionally, sophomores are given permission to do so.

SUSPENSION of ASSISTANCE DUE TO GPA/GRADES

- If a student does not earn a grade letter of “C” or above, or a GPA of 2.0 or above, in his or her AP class(es) funded by Quapaw Nation Higher Education (QNHE), that student will be given one (1) semester to raise his or her grade(s).
- If, at the end of the second semester, the student is still below a “C” or 2.0 in the QNHE funded AP class(es), he or she will be suspended from the QNHE AP Class Funding Assistance until the student’s grade(s) or GPA in AP class(es) is at a “C” or above, or 2.0 or above.
- At that time, the student can apply for funding and QNHE will consider his or her application on a case-by-case basis.

 - Parent/guardian **and**
 - Counselor/Principal
- Concurrent class schedule from high school indicating concurrent/dual credit/AP courses
- Completed application (pages 4, 5, and 6 of this packet)

Concurrent/Dual Credit Students:

- Semester schedule from college with itemized billing statement
- Final grades for each semester

AP Students:

- Final grades for each semester
- Receipt(s) for any required class fees
- Proof or registration or receipt of payment for AP Exams
- AP Exam scores once received

All applications must be post-marked, emailed, faxed, or turned in by 9/30/2020.
